# PSALM 8

## GROUP DISCUSSION:

Read Psalm 8

What stands out to you from this Psalm?

What setting helps you to be amazed by God's majesty and greatness the most? The sunset, the beach, the mountains, other? What do you think and feel in these moments?

If you are in Christ you belong to a group of people who can refer to God as "our Lord". I find great comfort when I remember my Christian community because I know I'm not alone, and that these people "get me" and support me. In what ways are you thankful that you belong to the church? Is there a specific example you can share with the group?

When you remember that you are part of God's kingdom and will be for eternity, are any specific worries eased? (for example: when I remember God's kingdom I worry less about finances or car trouble).
