GROUP DISCUSSION:

How do we know Jesus is presenting himself as a king? What aspects of his lordship on display in this passage are especially meaningful to you?

Read Luke 19:41-44. Why is it powerful to see Jesus weeping? Discuss the statement, "because you did not know the time of your visitation."

What does 2 Peter 3:9-10 teach us about the coming judgement?

How does Luke 19 demonstrate Jesus making outsiders insiders?

What are some of your favorite words (19:48) or works (19:37) of Jesus and why? Take some time to pray and praise God as a group mentioning these things to him.
