READINGS:

Deuteronomy 4:1-9 // Psalm 15

Mark 7:6-9, 14-23 // Colossians 4:2-6

ALL TO JESUS Colossians 4:2-6

GROUP DISCUSSION:

1. Read Colossians 4:2-6. What stands out to you from this passage? In what way do you need to respond to God's word?
2. Are you steadfast in prayer? If not, what things distract you from being a person of prayer?
3. In Paul's writings we regularly see an eschatological imminence: Jesus' return and final judgement could come at any moment. Because of this Paul tells the Colossians to be watchful. What effect should this "imminence" have on our lives and prayers?
4. Who in your life needs to hear and believe the gospel? As a community group will you pray that God would open doors for the gospel in these people's lives?
