## **PALM SUNDAY**

# When Jesus Isn't Who You Thought He Was!

### **GROUP DISCUSSION:**

Read Luke 19:28-44.

In Jesus 'day, people missed him (Luke 19:44) because they couldn't see how Jesus "succeeds by suffering" and "wins by loosing." How do our lectionary texts (Isaiah 52:13-53:12; Psalm 22:1-11; Philippians 2:5-11) demonstrate that? Why is the biblical picture of Jesus so compelling, but also so different from what the world values?

In our day, we can miss Jesus especially if we're looking for the wrong Jesus. There were three false/incomplete "types" of Jesus common in our culture that Pastor Rob mentioned -The "escape pod," "life coach," or "tolerant," Jesus. Discuss those and any more you might add (also see 2 Cor. 11:3-4).

How has your view of Jesus been shaped by these false views or other false views? How are you in danger of "missing Jesus?"
