

REVELATIONS

- According to Rev 1:3 blessed are those who read the book, hear the words of the prophecy and keeps (do) the words written.
- To receive the blessings of Revelation we are to: Read the book
- Understand that it is a prophetic book- meaning that it is history written beforehand and so it is history unfolding before us. Some things have occurred others we are waiting to occur.
- We are to follow or do the things it tells us. (Rev. 1:3, 2:26, 3:8, 10, 12:17, 14:12, 22:9)

APPROACH TO REVELATIONS

- Understand that it is prophetic
- It uses imagery, allusions, literal language, uses visions to describe what has happened and what will happen
- Approach to understanding using good criteria-
- use all available material but not go beyond what is revealed or known. Speculate on what could be or appears to be happening and use the Bible as reference



PAST, PRESENT, FUTURE

- Rev: 1:19 "Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are and the things which are to come."
- 1. He saw the vision of Christ- past
- 2. The thing which are concerning the churches- present 3. The things which shall be hereafter- future
- Rev. 4:1- "a door was opened in heaven, Jesus told John to come and see the things which must come."

CHIEF THEME OF REVELATIONS

• Rev. 1:7 "Behold he cometh with Clouds and every eye shall see him and they also which pierced him and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him."

Revelations is about the Return of Christ and his victory over evil

THINGS SEEN

- Vision of Christ
- 8 fold description- Body clothed with white and gold, Hair was white like wool and snow, eyes- flame of fire, feetbrass, voice- many waters, face- shined like the sun
- Told John to fear not (80 times in scripture), that he lives forever and has all authority.
- The seven stars are the seven angels (messengers) of the churches- believed to be the pastors and the seven candlesticks are the churches



PRESENT

- Things concerning those churches and many interpret to all churches until the Rapture
- 3 fold application of the Letters
- 1. Local Application
- 2. Prophetic Application
- 3. Individual Application
- Local application- letters portrayed actual events in 7 local churches in Turkey (Asia Minor)

FUTURE

 Prophetic Application- Could apply to churches throughout the dispensation until the Rapture, revealing spiritual conditions in local churches and in individuals in churches.

 Individual Churches- So that all individuals may be warned and learn from the failures of these churches

EPHESUS

 Pros- Works, Labor, Patience, not allowing evil in the church

Cons- Lost first Love- return back to first works or candlestick will be removed-best interpretation – church would no longer exist

 As of Today the Christian church is almost non-existence. Modern Turkey is 98.5% Muslim

RUINS AT EPHESUS





Pros- Works, tribulations in poverty,

Warned them about persecution

 Commended them to be faithful and fear not, even unto death

PERGAMOS

Pros- works, hold fast to his name, has not denied the faith even unto death

 Cons- False doctrines, eating things sacrificed to idols, committing fornication, holding the doctrines of the nicolaitaines

- •Know thy works- charity, service, faith, patience. Jesus had things against them- they suffered a woman named Jezebel- a false prophetess
- Told to hold fast and keep their works

SARDIS

- Pros- works, kept his word, still a few faithful, Have not denied Christ name
- Cons- reputation of being alive but it is dead.

 Encouraged to be watchful, strengthen themselves, make their works better

PHILADELPHIA

- Jesus said I know your works
- I have set before you an open door that no man can shut
- Has kept his word and not denied his name
- Hold fast to what you have

- I know your works- you are neither hot nor cold but lukewarm therefore I will spit you out
- You say you are rich and have plenty and need nothing but you are wretched, miserable and poor, blind and naked.
- Buy Gold tried by fire that you may be rich
- Buy new clothing
- Open your eyes with new eyesalve
- He will chasten and rebuke them therefore repent
