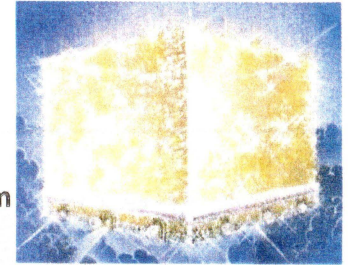

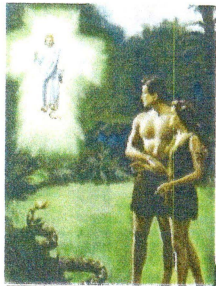

THE 15 DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE RAPTURE AND THE GLORIOUS APPEARING

Rapture / Blessed Hope	Glorious Appearing
1. Christ comes in the air for His own <i>1 Thessalonians 4:14-17</i>	1. Christ comes with His own to earth <i>Revelation 19:11-16</i>
2. Rapture/translation of all Christians <i>1 Thessalonians 4:16-17;</i> <i>1 Corinthians 15:50-54</i>	2. No one raptured
3. Christians taken to the Father's house <i>John 14:1-3</i>	3. Resurrected saints do not see Father's house
4. No judgment on earth	4. Christ judges inhabitants of earth <i>Matthew 25:31-46</i>
5. Church taken to heaven <i>1 Thessalonians 4:16-17</i>	5. Christ sets up His kingdom on earth <i>Revelation 19-20</i>
6. Imminent—could happen any moment <i>Matthew 24:42-44</i>	6. Cannot occur for at least 7 years <i>Daniel 9:26-29</i>
7. No signs	7. Many signs for Christ's physical coming <i>Matthew 24:3-36</i>
8. For believers only <i>1 Thessalonians 4:14</i>	8. Affects all humanity <i>Revelation 1:7</i>
9. A time of joy <i>Titus 2:13;</i> <i>1 Thessalonians 2:19-20; 4:18</i>	9. Time of mourning <i>Revelation 1:7</i>
10. Before the "day of wrath" (Tribulation) <i>Revelation 3:10;</i> <i>1 Thessalonians 5:8-9</i>	10. Immediately after Tribulation <i>Matthew 24:29-36</i>
11. No mention of Satan	11. Satan bound in abyss for 1000 years <i>Revelation 19:20-20:3</i>
12. The judgment seat of Christ <i>1 Corinthians 4:5;</i> <i>2 Corinthians 5:9-10</i>	12. No time or place for judgment seat of Christ
13. Marriage of the Lamb <i>Revelation 19:7-10</i>	13. His bride as an army descends with Him <i>Revelation 19:11-14;</i> <i>Jude 14</i>
14. Only His own see Him <i>1 Thessalonians 4:14-17</i>	14. Every eye will see Him <i>Revelation 1:7</i>
15. Tribulation begins <i>Matthew 24:9-32;</i> <i>2 Thessalonians 2:3-12</i>	15. 1000-year kingdom of Christ begins (Great White Throne) <i>Revelation 19:11-15; 20:4-6</i>
