## Ephesians 5:6–14 CSB

<sup>6</sup> Let no one deceive you with empty arguments, for God's wrath is coming on the disobedient because of these things. <sup>7</sup> Therefore, do not become their partners. <sup>8</sup> For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light—<sup>9</sup> for the fruit of the light consists of all goodness, righteousness, and truth—<sup>10</sup> testing what is pleasing to the Lord. <sup>11</sup> Don't participate in the fruitless works of darkness, but instead expose them. <sup>12</sup> For it is shameful even to mention what is done by them in secret. <sup>13</sup> Everything exposed by the light is made visible, <sup>14</sup> for what makes everything

visible is light. Therefore it is said: Get up, sleeper, and rise up from the dead, and Christ will shine on you.

#### **Romans 1:18–25 CSB**

<sup>18</sup> For God's wrath is revealed from heaven against all godlessness and unrighteousness of people who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth, <sup>19</sup> since what can be known about God is evident among them, because God has shown it to them. <sup>20</sup> For his invisible attributes, that is, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen since the creation of the world, being understood through what he has made. As a result, people are without excuse. <sup>21</sup> For though they knew God, they did not glorify him as God or show gratitude. Instead, their thinking became worthless, and their senseless hearts were darkened. <sup>22</sup> Claiming to be wise, they became fools <sup>23</sup> and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man, birds, four-footed animals, and reptiles. <sup>24</sup> Therefore God delivered them over in the desires of their hearts to sexual impurity, so that their bodies were degraded among themselves. <sup>25</sup> They exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served what has been created instead of the Creator, who is praised forever.
