Check-In:

- How did you spend Easter weekend? Do you have yearly traditions?

Discuss:

Exploring the question: Who is Jesus?

- Why do you think the question “Is Jesus the Messiah?” was so important in His time?
- Looking at Mark 14:61-62, what do you notice about Jesus’ response to the high priest?

Exploring the question: What if Jesus is the Messiah?

- What are the implications if Jesus really is who He claimed to be?
- How would that change the way you view His teachings or authority?

Exploring the question: What if Jesus is Alive?

- How important are eyewitness accounts when it comes to believing something like the resurrection?
- If Jesus truly rose from the dead, what does that mean about His identity and power?

Exploring the question: What if Jesus is Alive in Me?

- Looking at Romans 6:3-7, what does it mean to be “united with Him” in death and resurrection?
- Verse 6 talks about no longer being slaves to sin- what does that freedom look like in real life?

Reflect:

- If Jesus really is the Messiah and is alive today, what is one area of your life where you need to trust or follow Him more?
- What is something in your life that still feels like “slavery” (sin, fear, habits, pain), and what would it look like to live in the freedom Jesus offers?
- If Jesus is truly alive *in you*, how should that change the way you think, act, or respond in your daily life this week?
