The Bible For Regular People – Acts, Week 3

CHECK-IN:

- Who has had a significant influence on your faith journey, and what made their witness impactful?
- When you hear the word "witness," what comes to mind?

READ: Acts 6:1-8

DISCUSS:

- Stephen wasn't chosen because of his talents but because he was known as someone full of faith, wisdom, and the Holy Spirit. What stands out to you about those qualifications?
- What do you think people would say you're "full of" right now?

READ: Acts 6:9-15

DISCUSS:

- Stephen remained faithful even when falsely accused and opposed. Why is it often difficult to maintain a Christlike witness when we're misunderstood?
- The message noted that "boldly doesn't have to mean loudly." What does wise and gracious witness look like in today's culture?

READ: Acts 8:1-4 and Acts 1:8

DISCUSS:

- Stephen never saw the impact his faithfulness would have. Why do you think God often allows us to serve without seeing the full results?
- Can you think of a time when God used a difficult situation for a greater purpose than you could see at the time?

APPLY

The message challenged us to consider three questions:

1. **What am I being filled with?**
 - What habits or influences are currently shaping your heart and mind?
2. **What is my life giving witness to?**

- If someone observed your life for a week, what would they conclude is most important to you?

3. How can my witness be used by God?

- Who is one person you can share a story of God's faithfulness with this week?

Share prayer requests related to spiritual growth, faithfulness, courage, and being a witness for Jesus. Pray that God would fill each person with faith, wisdom, grace, and the Holy Spirit so their lives point others to Christ.
