

Weekend Message Questions

Local: Go Home

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**Please note: These notes reference the Frisco East streamed message, not each campus pastor's teaching.*

CHECK-IN: What is a place you have always considered "home," and what makes it feel like home to you?

READ: Luke 15:11-20 NLT

DISCUSS:

- What stands out to you about the younger son's decision to leave home and what he expected to find away from his father?
- What do you notice about the father's response when his son begins the journey home? What does this reveal about God's patience and love?

READ: Luke 15:20-24 NLT

DISCUSS:

- The father gives his returning son a robe, ring, and sandals. What do these details communicate about the son's identity and place in the family?
- Where are you tempted to believe you need to earn your place with God instead of receiving what is already yours as part of His family?

READ: Luke 15:25-32 NLT

DISCUSS:

- In what ways is the older brother also "lost," even though he never left home?
- How do the older and younger brothers each struggle with their place in the family, and how does the father pursue both of them?

READ: Luke 15:31-32 NLT

DISCUSS:

- What do you think the father means when he says, "everything I have is yours"? How might that change the way we see our relationship with God?
- What might it look like for us to stop behaving like servants and start living like family?

APPLY:

- Where do you need to come home to the Father? If you have been searching elsewhere for what can only be found in Him, what would turning home look like?
- If you have stayed close but recognize that your heart has become distant, what would it look like to return to His heart?
- This week, choose one way to live like family by volunteering, investing in others, celebrating someone's return or growth, or helping enlarge the table.

PRAYER TIME: Share prayer requests related to coming home to the Father, receiving His love instead of trying to earn it, and living with the identity, authority, and responsibility of being part of His family. Pray for those who feel far from God and for those who are close physically but distant in heart.
