CHECK-IN: Check with your group to see how they're doing.

BIG IDEA: If there was anyone in the Bible's "yearbook" who would be voted most unlikely to succeed, it would be Moses (by his own admission!). But we will see God graciously intervene in Moses's story in amazing ways.

READ: Exodus 3:1-13, 4:1, 4:10, 4:13

- Have you ever felt, like Moses, that you're in a desert and it's the only place you'll ever be?
- In what ways does this tend to make you feel unworthy, unqualified, or simply like God could never use you for anything good?
- Do you believe God does some of his best work in the deserts of our life? In what ways do we know this to be true?

READ: Jeremiah 1:5, Psalm 139:13-18

- According to God's Word, how unique has he made you? How intimately does he know you and the details of your life? How does knowing this help you trust Him with the different aspects of your life?
- What do you think God is asking you to do right now? What are the various things that tend to make you want to ignore him?

READ: Exodus 2:11-12

- What are the things from your past that make you want to run from God, or try to keep certain parts of your life hidden from him?
- In what ways can you instead be faithful to Him during this season of your life?
