BIG IDEA: Making the Cut: How we see the world and how we respond to it.

READ: Numbers 13:1-3, 17-20, 25-33

- We see two very different perspectives in this story; one of fear, and one of faith.
 Would you say your life perspective is typically one of fear or faith?
- What do you think are some of the things that result in a life perspective of fear?

READ: John 14:1-4, Romans 8:28

- What has been our perspective facing COVID the last year and a half? Fear or faith?

- What has been our perspective on world events? Fear or faith?
- What is your perspective about the challenge you are facing right now? Fear or faith?

- Have you been wandering in the desert? Have you settled for a life less than God's best? Have you been half in/ half out in our relationship with God? Have you been lukewarm, complacent, and uncommitted to Jesus?
- What has God shown you that you can repent of in order to recommit your life to Him and move into the center of His purpose?
