**CHECK-IN:**

- What plan do you have for the summer? Are you a beach or mountain person?
- When you hear the name “Jesus,” what is one word or title that comes to mind first? Why?

**READ: Numbers 21:4-9**

**DISCUSS:**

- What stands out to you most about Israel’s attitude toward God in this passage?
- “*Sin says: God, You are not enough for me.*” How do we still wrestle with that mindset today?
- How does this story point forward to Jesus and the cross?

**READ: 2 Corinthians 5:21**

**DISCUSS:**

- What does this verse teach us about the seriousness of sin?
- Why is it important that Jesus was fully God and fully man?
- How is Christianity different from a message of moral improvement or religious performance?

**READ: John 3:13-17**

**DISCUSS:**

- What words or phrases stand out most to you in this passage?
- Why is the phrase “whoever believes” so significant?
- Why do people often try to “fix themselves” before coming to God?

**APPLY**

- Where have you been looking for hope, healing, identity, or peace outside of Jesus?
- Do you tend to look: inward at failure, backward at shame, outward in comparison, rather than upward to Christ?
- What is one area of your life where you need to stop striving and start trusting Jesus?
- What is one practical step you can take this week to keep your eyes fixed on Christ?
- In what ways do you want your knowledge of God to become more transformational and personal?

Share prayer requests related to:

- Personal prayers that members walked in with
- A week of “look and live” in faith
- God would deepen your love for Jesus and help you encounter Him personally through His Word, prayer, and worship this week.
