CHECK-IN: What is one voice (person, habit, or message) that has shaped the way you think over the years?

READ

Genesis 3:1–7

DISCUSS

1. What stands out to you about how the serpent speaks to Eve?
2. What lies do you notice in this passage, and why do you think they were so convincing?

READ

Matthew 4:1–4

DISCUSS

1. How does the enemy try to tempt Jesus in this first encounter?
2. What do you learn from how Jesus responds to the lie of quick comfort?

READ

Matthew 4:5–7

DISCUSS

1. Why do you think the enemy attacks Jesus' identity before His actions?
2. Where are you most tempted to seek quick certainty instead of trusting God?

READ

Matthew 4:8–10

DISCUSS

1. What shortcuts does the enemy offer Jesus in this final temptation?
2. How do these same temptations show up in our lives today?

APPLY

- What lie do you feel most tempted to believe right now?
- How does belonging to Jesus change the way you respond to temptation?
- What is one practical way you can stay close enough to Jesus to recognize His voice this week?

PRAYER TIME

Share prayer requests related to discernment, trust, and freedom from lies. Pray that each person would grow in their ability to recognize and follow the voice of Jesus.
