CHECK-IN: Check with the members of your group to see how they are doing.

ICEBREAKER DISCUSSION:

- What comes to mind when you think of the word “committed” or “commitment”?
- What does being committed to Jesus really mean to you?

READ: Romans 10:9-10

- What stands out to you in this passage?
- Between a baseline commitment (like the thief on the cross) and an exceptional commitment (like the apostle Paul) where would you put your commitment to Jesus?
- A Jesus decision is an acknowledgment and acceptance of who Jesus is and what Jesus did on the cross and through his resurrection. Have you made that decision? If yes, will you share your experience with us?

READ: Matthew 6:33, Luke 9:23-24, Mark 12:29-31

- What stands out to you in these passages?
- What does a “kingdom first lifestyle” mean to you?
- Living a kingdom first lifestyle is prioritizing the kingdom of God above our own, in every of our lives including: our decisions, spiritual growth, community, money, etc. In which ways would you say you live a kingdom first lifestyle? Which areas of your life are more difficult for you to commit to a kingdom first lifestyle?

READ: Matthew 28:19-20, 2 Corinthians 5:18-21

- What stands out to you in these passages?
- Do you have a missional mindset? How?
- What external or internal factors might be keeping you from the “missional mindset” level of commitment to Jesus? How can you practically grow in this area?
