Weekend Message Questions Traditions, Week 2: Communion 10/09 - 10/10

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CHECK-IN: Check with the members of your group to see how they are doing. How did everyone do with last week's DIY? (*Read the Apostle's Creed this week as a part of your time with God and pray that He would continue to strengthen your faith through these statements.*) Does your family have a tradition that is special to you?

BIG IDEA: Communion

What are the names for communion found in Jude 1:12, Matthew 26:26, Luke 22:19, 24:30, Acts 2:42, 1 Corinthians 10:16, 10:21, 11:20, 11:24, 11:37?

READ: Exodus 12:1-3, 5-8, & 12-17 When was the first Passover? What was required? Why was it important to repeat the tradition of Passover through the generations to come?

READ: Luke 22:7-20 As the disciples were celebrating the Passover together, what was it they were to remember? How does Jesus transform the Passover tradition?

What is the reminder in 1 Corinthians 12:27?

READ: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

Communion is a reminder of who He is and what He has done as well as who we are and that we are His body. What does that mean to you?

DIY: Pause one time each day of this week to remember what Jesus has done for us at the cross.
