 do you balance grace and truth in discipline?

READ:

Proverbs 22:6

DISCUSS:

- What role does modeling play in parenting? What does it mean to "be the example" for your children?
- In what areas of your life is it most challenging to model Christian values for your children?
- How do you handle it when you fail to live up to the standards you want to set for your children? How do you demonstrate repentance and grace?
- How do you think culture impacts the way Christian parents raise their children today?
 What specific challenges do modern parents face?
- What role does the church community play in supporting parents in raising their children?
