The Bible For Regular- Acts, Week 1

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CHECK-IN:

- When you hear the phrase “Holy Spirit,” what’s the first thing that comes to mind?
- Have you ever experienced a moment where you sensed God guiding, comforting, or convicting you?

READ: Acts 1:4-5

DISCUSS:

- What stands out to you about the fact that the disciples had already spent years with Jesus, yet still needed the Holy Spirit?
- Why do you think dependence is often viewed as weakness instead of strength?
- How can prayer help cultivate dependence on the Holy Spirit?

READ:Acts 1:8a

DISCUSS:

- What comes to mind when you hear the word "witness"?
- How does the phrase "God does not call the equipped; He equips the called" challenge or encourage you?
- Who are some ordinary people in Scripture that God used in extraordinary ways?

READ:Acts 1:8b-11

DISCUSS:

- What do you think Jesus was teaching the disciples through His instructions about Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the ends of the earth?
- What kinds of things distract believers from God's mission today?
- How can Christians move from passive observation to active participation in God's mission?

APPLY

- Which part of today's message challenged you the most: dependence on the Spirit, empowerment for mission, or clarity of purpose?

- Where do you need the Holy Spirit's power most right now?
- If someone looked at your life today, would they see someone primarily dependent on yourself or dependent on God?

PRAYER TIME

Spend time praying for:

- Greater dependence on the Holy Spirit.
- Courage to be faithful witnesses.
- Clarity in living out Jesus' mission.
- Specific people God has placed in your life who need to know Him.
