CHECK-IN: Check with the members of your group to see how they are doing.

TAKEAWAY: The Lord's Prayer calls us to honor and revere God as Father. The question, then, isn't whether or not God is going to be honored and holy, but am I going to keep Him honored and holy in my life?

READ: Matthew 6:9

DISCUSS:

- Would you say God feels more like the "big man upstairs" or like a loving Father?
- Does God feel close and intimately involved in your life or like He's a million miles away?

READ: 2 Chronicles 20:6; Revelation 21:6a; Galatians 6:7-8

DISCUSS:

- Who have been healthy examples of an authority in your life? Who up to this point would you honestly say has had ultimate authority over your life?
- What aspects of your life would you say are not under the full authority of God? What do you think would have to change in order for God to become your ultimate authority?

READ: Psalm 23:1-6

DISCUSS:

- What parts of this passage from Psalm 23 do you find encouraging and hopeful? What parts do you struggle with and would find it difficult to pray or confess to God?
- Share with one another the various ways in your life in which you have experienced God as guide, leader, protector, comforter, friend, and/or counselor.

TAKEAWAY: As we pray "Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be your name," we are confessing who he already is. But more importantly, we are confessing who He is in our lives: our authority and our shepherd.

- Read Psalm 23:1-6 every day this week as you continue in 21 Days of Prayer
