- John 6:5-13

  - Jesus walks on water. What thoughts would you have if you were on a boat on rough waters and all the sudden Jesus appears, and even better, He is walking on water?
  - There is no challenge you will face alone!
- John 13:12-4-5, 13:12-17
  - Jesus washes the disciples' feet. Would you be willing to worship the feet of those God calls you to teach?
  - The path to blessing is humility!
- John 14:1-3, 14:12-14, 16:16-17, 16:26, 16:27, 15:5
  - Jesus gives encouraging words. How do you make the effort to keep God's promises at the forefront of your thoughts? How do you do this when it is the hardest?
  - When life gets tough, remember My promises!
- John 16:1-4
  - Jesus gives a warning. Has there ever been a time you wanted to give up on God? If you did, talk about what brought you back to God? If not, how do you keep strong in your faith?
  - o Don't walk away when it gets tough.
- John 20:19-21
  - o Jesus' Resurrection. Why is the resurrection so significant?
  - o Through My Resurrection there is peace, hope, and purpose!

- If you are still deciding about following Jesus, what questions do you have?
- Where is Jesus calling you to take a step in your faith?
