BIG IDEA: Field Trip Gone Bad

READ: Exodus 14:10-12

Can you imagine how the people of Israel felt?

Have you ever been in a situation which you felt was impossible?

Read about the God's miracle that solved their challenge in Exodus 14:13-14, 21-22.

God does not always provide a miracle when we face challenging situations. Sometimes He provides peace as we walk through a painful challenge or He provides eternity, another kind of miracle as we walk through death. But sometimes, He provides a miracle...So don't be afraid to ask.

Have you experienced God's provision during a challenging time?

Read about the Israelites' next chapter of challenge in Exodus 16:3 17:1-2.

Do you think you might have been a part of the complaining?

Have you ever been in a place in your life where God was the only way in which provision was going to come?

READ: Exodus 16:11-12 & Philippians 4:11-12

How can lack of contentment or lack of stewardship affect your need or perceived need of provision?

What was the key to the Israelites victory as they battled in Exodus 17:8-13?

Our physical battles are physical manifestations of what's going on in the spiritual realm. We can't fight physically, but how can we fight spiritually according to Ephesians 6:10-18?

READ: Exodus 32:1-6

Have you experienced a time when you felt God took too long to answer you? Did you end up taking matters into your own hands?

What does it look like to approach God with an attitude of humility?

DIY: Reflect on an area of your life that is difficult to trust God with. Pray the Lord's prayer and practice surrendering control to God.
