Weekend Message Questions Week 4: My Name Is _____ "Simon to Peter" January 27 & 28, 2024

CHECK-IN:

- Begin your group session by checking in with each member.
 - o How is everyone doing?
 - Have you decided what your group format will be for the start of 2024?

READ: Matthew 14:22-32

DISCUSS:

- Peter's life has many moments in his life of extreme faith and extreme failure, how can you relate?
- Talk about a time that you have been called by God to an uncomfortable place and you said no.
- Talk about a time that you were called and fearfully moved forward to what God is calling you to.
- What has God been calling you to that you continue to ignore?

READ: Matthew 16:13-18

DISCUSS:

• If Jesus asked you the same question, "But who do you say I am?" how would you respond? Why?

READ: Luke 22:54-62

DISCUSS:

- Peter denies Jesus Christ, he reaches the point of extreme failure, what has been a moment like this for you?
- Peter had a purpose, even though he denied Christ, God still restored him and he was used to share the gospel with so many people. Do you need to be reminded of God's restoration for you? What does restoration look like for you?

DISCUSS:

- As we look at the last four weeks, we can see that each person sinned and struggled even after they committed to Christ. Reflect on the truth that God can still use you as he used each of these people.
- What is the next step for you to take, in your calling from God? What is your step into obedience?
- What labels have you given yourself that you need to cross-out?
- Share what you wrote down on the card received/present in service this weekend?

PRAY:

- Who comes to mind when you consider who to write down to pray over, that is far from God?
- Close the session with prayer, by sharing prayer requests and lifting each other up in prayer.
