READ: Psalm 51:1-17

DISCUSS:

- What is your response when the Holy Spirit convicts you of your sin?

READ: 2 Samuel 12:13-20

DISCUSS:

- How has facing the consequences of past decisions impacted your relationship with God?
- How do you receive God's discipline?

READ: Romans 2:4, Hebrews 12:10-11

- What have you learned from your responses to accountability and discipline?
