Weekend Message Questions The Pursuit of Wisdom Week 4: The Money Principles of Proverbs 6/25 - 6/26

CHECK-IN: Check with the members of your group to see how they are doing. How did everyone do with last week's DIY? (Spend time in prayer this week. Ask God to help you use your words to build others up and to encourage others on a daily basis.) What is some of the wisest advice you have received regarding finances?

BIG IDEA: Wisdom with Money; The Money Principles of Proverbs

What warnings about greed do we find in these scriptures: Proverbs 1:19, Proverbs 23:4, & Proverbs 15:27? How is it that greed robs us of life? What can God do through you with your wealth?

READ: Proverbs 3:9-10 and 2 Corinthians 9:6 How can we honor the Lord with our money? What is the difference between honoring God with our finances verses just giving?

What does the Bible have to say about hard work according to Proverbs 10:4, Proverbs 12:11, and Proverbs 28:19-20?

Hard work is using our God given giftings, ideas, creativity with His purpose in mind. What does that look like for you?

What is the principle of stewardship found in Proverbs 3:9-10?

READ: Proverbs 27:23-24 & Proverbs 6:6-11 What do these verses say about finances? What is your experience with creating and living on a budget? How does minimizing your debt help honor God? How does the ability to consistently save factor into being good stewards?

Stewardship is the understanding that everything we have is from God and it matters to Him that we manage well because He is for us. What changes can you make in your finances to show honor to God in your stewardship?

DIY: Spend time in prayer this week. Ask God to highlight areas where you can practice generosity and to use your time, talent, and treasures to help build His kingdom.
