CHECK-IN: Check with the members of your group to see how they are doing.

BIG IDEA: While the flesh, the world, and the Devil attack us, in Christ we have redemption from our enemies.

READ: Galatians 5:16-24, Romans 8:5-11

DISCUSS:

- According to Paul, what are the different ways in which our flesh tends to distort our desires in ways that move us away from God?
- How would you say these things of the flesh oppose God?
- What do you think Paul means by, "those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires"?

READ: Romans 12:2, John 8:44b; 10:10a; 17:15

DISCUSS:

- In light of Jesus's command to love our neighbors, how can we love people without conforming to the world?
- What are the different ways Scripture tells us the enemy tries to attack us?

READ: Romans 7:15-25, John 16:5-13, 1 John 4:4

DISCUSS:

- In what ways do you relate with the internal struggle Paul describes in Romans 7?
- What are some of the details for redemption from this struggle that Jesus describes for us in Scripture?
- How might you increase practices such as reading the Bible, prayer, fasting, etc. in order to grow in your relationship with Jesus?

DIY: Take five minutes of stillness everyday before starting out your day praying 'Your Kingdom come, Your will be done.'
