CHECK-IN:

- If your group has not seen Kiwi's story that was shared during serve take a moment to watch it or retell it

READ: 1 John 5:14-15, Jeremiah 29:13

DISCUSS:

- Kiwi's story reminds us that God is near to us and hears our prayers.
- Do you feel like your prayers are aligned with God's will? Why or why not?
- What areas of your life are you currently seeking God half-heartedly instead of wholeheartedly?

READ: Mark 10:45, John 13:12-17

DISCUSS:

- Kiwi's story reminds us of the impact we can have when we serve others.
- When you hear "serve others," what emotions or thoughts come up?
- What motivates you more: love for others or a sense of obligation? Why?

READ: Hebrews 10:24-25, John 13:34-35

DISCUSS:

- Kiwi's story reminds us of the impact a community of believers can have.
- What does "spur one another on toward love and good deeds" look like in practical terms?
- Who in your life encourages you in your faith? How can you intentionally do that for someone else this week?

APPLY

- What gifts or strengths has God given you that you can use to serve others more effectively?

- What would it look like for our group to serve together in a tangible way?
- How can serving others point people to Christ in your current season of life?

PRAYER TIME

Share prayer requests related to the things shared from the group questions. How can we as individuals seek and trust God more as well as serve others as God has asked us too.

The Lord will equip you to serve others; you just have to say yes in the day to day, through your group and around the world.
