CHECK-IN: Check with the members of your group to see how they are doing.

WEEK 3: Give, Forgive, Deliver

READ Matthew 6:5-13. Give Us Today Our Daily Bread

DISCUSS: When you pray, do you begin with a request or gratitude?

DISCUSS:

1. When we come to him we are acknowledging that he is our provider.
 - a. Without him we are nothing.
2. We are invited to make our requests.
 - a. We need to align ourselves with God's will. He knows our needs before we even ask.

READ 1 Kings 3:5-14

DISCUSS: How can you pray less out of selfishness and more out of His wisdom?

If we can learn to ask for the right things, the benefits would far outweigh anything we could ever selfishly ask for.

READ Matthew 6: 14-15

DISCUSS: Is forgiveness, asking for or offering, something that comes naturally to you or something you need work on?

DISCUSS: How often are you asking God for forgiveness in your prayers?

Forgiveness is about releasing ourselves from roots of bitterness, resentment, and unhealthy relational tendencies.

Forgiveness is also about loving our neighbor as much as we love ourselves.

READ Matthew 6:13

READ James 1:13-15

DISCUSS: What temptation do we lead ourselves into?

Lead us not into temptation (lead us in the opposite direction of our own evil desires) and deliver us from the evil one (deliver us from the desire of our enemy to deceive and destroy us).

DISCUSS: Where is God asking us to take the next step?
