Love Your Neighbor, Week 1: Mutual Brokenness

CHECK-IN:

- What's a movie with a plot twist that really surprised you?
- Have you ever experienced a "plot twist" moment in your own life where things didn't go as expected?

READ: Luke 10:25–27

DISCUSS:

- Why do you think Jesus answered the question with another question? What might He have been trying to reveal about the man's heart?
- What does it practically look like to love God with all your heart, soul, strength, and mind in your current season?

READ: Luke 10:29–32

DISCUSS:

- Why do you think the priest and the Levite chose to pass by? What might have felt like an "interruption" to them?
- When have you been tempted to see someone's need as an inconvenience rather than an opportunity?

READ: Luke 10:33–37

DISCUSS:

- What makes the Samaritan's actions so surprising in this story?
- What stands out to you about the way the Samaritan responded—his compassion, action, or sacrifice?

READ: Ephesians 2:8–9

DISCUSS:

- Why is it important to understand that we are saved by grace, not by our works?
- How does seeing yourself as the one in need (the man on the road) change the way you view this story?

APPLY

- Where might God be inviting you to see interruptions as opportunities this week?
- What has God already entrusted to you (time, resources, relationships), and how can you use it to serve someone else?
- How does recognizing Jesus as your “Good Samaritan” shape your response to others?

PRAYER TIME

Share prayer requests related to areas where you need healing, growth, or trust in God. Pray that God would help you recognize His invitations in everyday moments and respond with compassion, remembering what He has done for you.
