REFLECT

1. What did your family intentionally do to make memories when you were growing up?
2. What songs created the soundtrack of your childhood? What songs do you go back to regularly as a source of truth and encouragement?

ENCOUNTER

How quickly we forget the works of our great God! We can be just like the children of Israel who saw God display his wonders in Egypt and were set free only to grumble when they got to the Red Sea. If we are to fight the sin of forgetfulness, we must actively remember what God has done for us. We must remind ourselves and others of the works of our God. One great gift for memory is music.
