SERMON STUDY



God wants us to know his immeasurable strength. And how has he made it known to us? Ephesians 1:20-23 tell us that God's power is made known to us through Christ's victory over death and his God-given authority over Satan and his horde. Spiritual evil is crushed under Christ's feet.
