1. What did you need to hear most from this week's sermon?

ENCOUNTER

As we launch our series in the final chapters of the Gospel of John, the Road to the Cross, meditate upon the passion week of Jesus. Regularly reading the text before a sermon can help us engage with the sermon. Read John 18:28-19:16. Prepare for the coming sermons by studying these verses together.

2. First, scan over all of John 18 and 19. How would you outline these verses?
3. What questions do you have that you think the sermons should address?
4. Do you see yourself in any of the characters that Jesus encounters in these verses?
5. One of the key verses of John is John 20:31, "But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name." How do these verses expand or confront your belief in Jesus? Does anything surprise you?
