A POEM FOR TRINITY SUNDAY

‘Trinitie Sunday’ by George Herbert

*Lord, who has form’d me out of mud,
And hast redeem’d me through thy bloud
And sanctifi’d me to do good;*

*Purge all my sinnes done heretofore:
For I confesse my heavy score,
And I will strive to sinne no more.*

*Enrich my heart, mouth, hands in me,
With faith, with hope, with charitie;
That I may runne, rise, rest with thee.*

June 4th is Trinity Sunday, a holy day when the Church marks the doctrine of the Trinity— not as a mental obstacle or logical embarrassment which Christians must either diminish or ignore altogether—but as a fundamental part of the story of our salvation. God is Triune (literally ‘three-one’), and were this not the case, we would be without hope.

Unsurprisingly, the great Anglican Priest and Poet George Herbert has written a poem for exactly this occasion, the poem he simply called “Trinitie Sunday.” Notice that the content is not only Trinitarian, the shape and the structure of the poem also reflect the Triune God. The three stanzas are each broken down into three lines, some of which feature three poetic statements on the work of the Triune God. Stanza one focuses on Triune God as creator, redeemer, and sanctifier; stanza two emphasizes the Triune God as the one who hears confession and purges sin that we may sin no more; and the final stanza brings us to see the Triune God as the place of our final rest. Enjoy this short, powerful poetic piece about our infinite, eternal, Triune God of love this Trinity Sunday.

A Collect for Trinity Sunday: Almighty and everlasting God, you have given to us your servants grace, by the confession of a true faith, to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity, and in the power of your divine Majesty to worship the Unity: Keep us steadfast in this faith and worship, and bring us at last to see you in your one and eternal glory, O Father; who with the Son and the Holy Spirit live and reign, one God, for ever and ever. **Amen.**

ZETEO UPDATE – MOST ARE HEALTHY!

Zeteo continues to work toward licensure and accreditation and is slowly making progress. Christian, the elementary education teacher, passed his certification exam and now has his license. He is helping get together all the paperwork for the private school license they need. Just Projects is going to pay for a full-time social worker for Zeteo and is currently working with Kate to interview qualified candidates. The hope is to have two full time social workers by September. All the house parents have received their TBRI (trust based relational intervention) training, and they also received their annual training in heat stroke as the temperature is soaring in the Philippines!

Kate is still looking at a future move, but it is not imminent. Most of the staff and children at Zeteo are once again healthy! Parker has severe skin rashes, and Hannah has swollen feet, cause unknown. Kate broke her hand and dislocated a finger but thankfully surgery is not necessary. Most of the children are now potty trained (Hannah and Ezekiel have disabilities that preclude this). Kate asks that we send underwear for the kids, both boys and girls, in the smallest size we can find. She said the underwear there is “terrible”! Our next box packing is June 10th. If you would like to donate a package of underpants, please put them in the Zeteo box at the back of the church! Thank you.

THE TRINITY

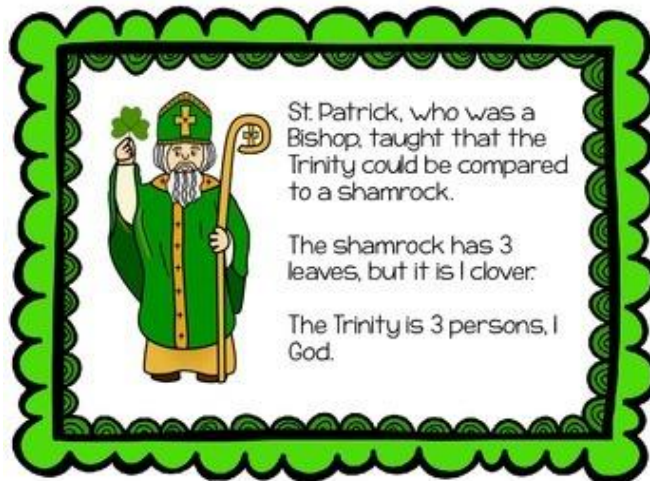
Just like the leaves

SAINT BARNABAS FEAST DAY JUNE 11th



Saint Barnabas, although not well known, is mentioned in the *New Testament* (Acts), and he is considered one of the first prophets of the Church. Born of Jewish parents of the tribe of Levi, his original name was Joseph. His native land was Cyprus. As a landholder he sold his land and gave the money to the church in Jerusalem. After Paul's conversion and return to Jerusalem, Barnabas took him in and introduced him to the Apostles. Barnabas and Paul both worked together in Antioch to serve the Christian movement. After about two years the Antiochene Church sent both Barnabas and Paul back to Jerusalem with their famine relief offering for the Jerusalem Church. A later dispute separated Barnabas and Paul, and Barnabas took John Mark as his companion on a journey to Cyprus.

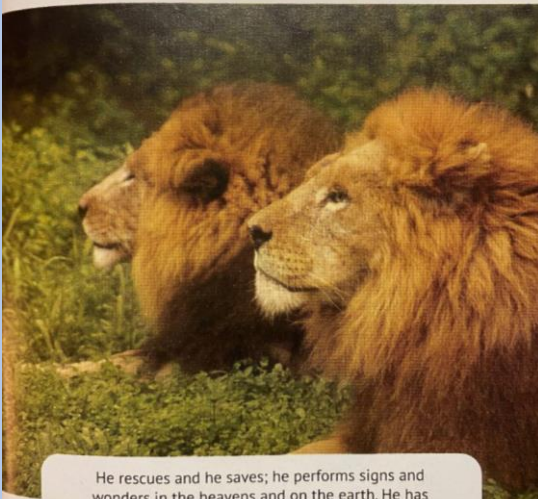


Barnabas continued as missionary of the *Gospel* for the rest of his life, and he was most successful among the Jews. So successful, in fact, that in AD 61 he was killed by Jews who dragged him from a synagogue and stoned him to death. A monastery was built in his name at Salamis, Cyprus, where his remains are interred. He was made the Patron Saint of Cyprus and Antioch. He is the Patron Saint against hailstones, and he is also invoked as a peacemaker. Saint Barnabas' Feast Day is celebrated annually on June 11th.
