Margaret Minnie Pollard Amie was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania on May 7, 1938, to Alphonse and Lucy Pollard. She was the fourth of 7 children. Margaret spent several of her foundational years in Detroit, MI with her Great Aunt and Uncle Laura and Wyatt Dickerson. Margaret accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Israel Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Rev. Samuel S. Jenkins. She actively participated as a member of the BYPU (Baptist Young People's Union) and the Pastor's Chorus.

She began her education in the Detroit Wayne County School system and later returned to Pennsylvania where she graduated from Swissvale High School in Swissvale, PA. She was a member of the glee club and aspired to be an Opera singer. When she returned to Swissvale, she united with Union Baptist Church under the pastorate of the late Pastor Wilkerson. She met and married Dudley Amie and they wed September 20, 1960. To this union four daughters were born, affectionately known as "My Girls", Wendy, Dawn, Christy, and Marlette.

Margaret began her career in health care as a dietary aide at Mercy Hospital. Upon moving back to Detroit, MI she began working in the field of early education. She started as a lunchroom aide at George School. She attended Wayne State University where she studied to become a certified teachers assistant. She used her training to help shape young minds and encouraged them to stay on the right path. She rejoined Israel Baptist Church under the pastorate of the late Rev. Jenkins. She served faithfully as a member of the choir. She also lived several years in Copperas Cove, Texas while there she became a certified at home daycare provider and later worked at Trinity Methodist daycare. She joined Bibleway Missionary Baptist Church under the pastorate of the late, Pastor Shannon D. McMullen where she also sang in the Mass Choir.

After retiring she later relocated to Nashville, TN. Here she joined Mt. Zion Baptist Church under the leadership of Bishop Joseph W. Walker, III. Even in her retirement she continued to find ways to serve. She assisted with the community feeding program at Curtis Hollow Towers and was an avid "Puzzle Buddy" in the community day room. Margaret loved to attend church services and spend time with her family. She always had a warm smile and an encouraging word to offer to anyone she encountered.

On November 2, 2023, Margaret was called home to her eternal rest surrounded by her close family.
