



WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH





Amanda Smith (January 23, 1837 – February 24, 1915) was born into slavery in Maryland. Her father, Samuel Berry bought his freedom and the freedom of his wife and children, and moved the family to Pennsylvania, a free state, where their home became a station on the Underground Railroad. Amanda married

twice but was left a widow at the age of 32 after the death of her second husband, James Smith. Amanda Berry Smith experienced the saving grace of Jesus during a Baptist revival. Her deepest desire was to share God's good news of salvation. Amanda spoke her message of salvation in both black and white churches and at camp meetings. She faced barriers being a "colored" woman preacher. In time, her evangelistic work took her to England, India, Africa, and back to the United States where she founded the Amanda Smith Orphans Home near Chicago, Illinois. An humble woman of great faith and prayer, Amanda Berry Smith went to be with her Lord in 1915 at the age of seventy-eight.
