Conclusion: First Words

1. Last words often reveal what was important to a person in their lifetime. What do you want to be remembered for? What kind of legacy do you want to leave?
2. PD made the case that "kerygma" (preach the Word) means much more than delivering sermons. It's telling the story of what God has done (the Gospel). What does it look like for YOU to "preach the Word"?
3. Why do you think Paul says we must have "makrothumia" (BIG patience) with people as we tell them the Gospel story?
4. How does the knowledge that Jesus is coming again empower you to preach the Word, endure hardship, and long for the day of His return?
