2. One sign of relying on talent is only saying "yes" to tasks we excel at or feel comfortable doing. When was the last time God called you out of your comfort zone, and how did you rely on Him to get through it?
3. The Holy Spirit gives gifts like peace, healing, and the ability to live Holy lives, but the primary command is to make disciples. How does shifting our focus from "what the Spirit can do for me" to "how the Spirit can use me to reach others" change our daily prayer life?
4. During the introduction, the church prayed: "Lord, my ears are open, my heart receptive. Speak to me. I will respond!" What is one specific area of your life this week where you need to step out in His power rather than your own strength?
