DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Peter says the false teachers are bold and arrogant in matters they do not understand. Specifically, they deny the existence of Satan, demons, and a literal hell (which doesn't cause those things to go away... it just demonstrates their ignorance). What is something you were once confident in, but God has changed your mind through His Word?
2. In verse 13, Peter says the false teachers are "blots and blemishes." Read Ephesians 5:25-27 and explain why this is actually a very serious charge against the false teachers?
3. Not only is false teaching foolish, but Peter also says it is EMPTY. Name some things that the worldly way of thinking PROMISES ... yet it is not able to deliver. Thinking about those same things, how does faith in Christ ultimately provide these things (and more)?
4. PD said the essence of the False Gospel is that we can have the blessings of God and still be our own Master. In what areas of life have you lived (or continue to live) as though YOU are the Master? Will you surrender those areas to Jesus today?
