Tuesday, April 21st

Day 1: The Focus of the Spirit - Exalting Jesus



Reading: John 14:15-26

Devotional: The Holy Spirit's primary work is to glorify Jesus Christ, not to draw attention to Himself or create spectacular experiences for their own sake. When the Spirit moves in our lives, He always points us toward Jesus as Lord—not just in profession, but in lifestyle. Today, examine your spiritual experiences. Do they lead you to deeper obedience to Christ? Or do they remain merely emotional moments that fade by Monday? True spiritual activity transforms us into the image of Christ, producing fruit that remains. The Spirit doesn't want you to admire Jesus from a distance; He wants you to follow Him closely, step by step, moment by moment. Ask yourself: does my life declare Jesus as Lord?

Wednesday, April 22nd

Day 2: The Source and Purpose - Grace for Building Others

Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:4-7

Devotional: Every spiritual gift flows from the same divine source—the Triune God working in perfect unity. These gifts aren't earned achievements or spiritual trophies to collect; they're grace-given abilities to profit others. Notice the text says gifts are given "to each one"—no one is excluded from this calling to build up the body. The question isn't whether you have a gift, but whether you're using it for others' benefit. Are you investing your spiritual gifts to see eternal profit in people's lives? Or have you fallen into a rut of Sunday attendance without genuine spiritual impact? God has equipped you specifically to make an eternal difference in someone's life. That's not about you—it's about His grace working through you.

Thursday, April 23rd

Day 3: Prophecy - Speaking Life to Others

Reading: 1 Corinthians 14:1-5

Devotional: Paul exhorts every believer to desire the gift of prophecy—the ability to speak truth that builds up, encourages, and strengthens others. This isn't about predicting the future; it's about speaking God's comfort and exhortation into present struggles. Think about the people in your life facing discouragement, anger, or doubt. You cannot pull them out of their pit, but you can comfort them in it with Scripture-aligned truth. When you speak words that edify, exhort, and comfort—always consistent with God's Word—you're exercising this gift. Who needs you to speak life into their darkness today? Don't underestimate the power of reminding someone of a biblical truth they've known for years but desperately need to hear right now.

Friday, April 24th

Day 4: Discernment - Seeing Through Deception

Reading: 1 John 4:1-6

Devotional: We live surrounded by counterfeit spirituality and false teaching. The gift of discerning spirits enables believers to distinguish between true and false influences, protecting the body from deception. False teachers are smooth with their words, twisting Scripture for personal gain. This gift is desperately needed today as we're inundated with social media voices claiming spiritual authority. How do you test what you hear? Everything must align with God's Word. Don't just consume content from popular voices—evaluate everything by Scripture. Are you reading God's Word enough to recognize when someone contradicts it? Your spiritual discernment grows as you saturate yourself in biblical truth. Protect yourself and others by knowing the Word deeply enough to spot the counterfeits.

Saturday, April 25th

Day 5: Breaking Free from Spiritual Ruts

Reading: James 4:6-10

Devotional: It's easy to fall into spiritual ruts—going through religious motions while your heart remains distant from God. Maybe you show up on Sunday half-heartedly, motivated more by what others think than genuine worship. Perhaps you're too distracted by lesser things to focus on what matters eternally. The good news? No rut is too deep for grace to rescue you from. But it requires humility—acknowledging where you truly are spiritually. Ask God today: What have I said yes to that I should have said no to? What's distracting me from following You wholeheartedly? Your children are watching. Your sphere of influence is waiting. Eternity is at stake. Humble yourself before the Lord today. Cry out for Him to pull you from the rut and renew your passion for His kingdom purposes.
