Confession of Faith

The Athanasian Creed (Paragraphs 10-11)

Minister: Christian, what is the catholic* faith?

Congregation: But it is necessary for eternal salvation that one also believe in the incarnation of our Lord Jesus Christ faithfully. Now this is the true faith: That we believe and confess that our Lord

Jesus Christ, God's Son, is both God and human, equally.

He is God from the essence of the Father, begotten before time; and He is human from the essence of His mother, born in time; completely God, completely human, with a rational soul and human flesh; equal to the Father as regards divinity, less than the Father as regards humanity.

This is the catholic* faith: one cannot be saved without believing it firmly and faithfully

Minister: Which is the tenth commandment?

Congregation: The tenth commandment is: Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his man-servant, nor his maid-servant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbour's.

Minister: What is required in the tenth commandment?

Congregation: The tenth commandment requireth full contentment with our own condition, with a right and charitable frame of spirit toward our neighbour, and all that is his.

May I Come To The Lord's Table?

At San Diego Reformed Church, we commit ourselves to observe The Lord's Supper at every Lord's Day service. We are a church that cherishes the Word of God. You also acknowledge to the elders of this congregation that you are in covenant with God, being active in a congregation which is covenantally bound to the triune God through Word and sacrament.






