Minister: Christian, what is the catholic* faith?

Minister: What rule hath God given for our direction in prayer?

Minister: What doth the preface of the Lord's Prayer teach us?

Congregation: The preface of the Lord's Prayer, which is Our Father which art in heaven, teacheth us to draw near to God with all holy reverence and confidence, as children to a Father, able and ready to help us; and that we should pray with and for others.

You also acknowledge to the elders of this congregation that you are in covenant with God, being active in a congregation which is covenantally bound to the triune God through Word and sacrament.
