### **Confession of Faith**

#### The Athanasian Creed (Paragraph 4)

Minister: Christian, what is the catholic\* faith?

Congregation: Thus the Father is Lord, the Son is Lord, the Holy Spirit is Lord. Yet there are not three lords; there is but one Lord. Just as Christian truth compels us to confess each person individually as both God and Lord, so catholic religion forbids us to say that there are three gods or lords.

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This is the catholic\* faith: one cannot be saved without believing it firmly and faithfully.

### May I Come To The Lord's Table?

At San Diego Reformed Church, we commit ourselves to observe The Lord's Supper at every Lord's Day service. We are a church that cherishes the Word of God. Accordingly, our service is filled with the Word. We pray the Word, recite the Word, sing the Word, sit under the preaching of the Word, and at the height of it all, sit down to feast upon the Word.

God has already prepared the table for us. So, we warmly invite to the Lord's table all those who are baptized disciples of Jesus Christ, under the authority of Christ and His body, the Church. By eating the bread and drinking the wine with us as a visitor, you are acknowledging that you are a sinner (spiritually poor and sick, as Calvin put it), without hope except in the sovereign mercy of God, and that you are trusting in Jesus Christ alone for salvation. You also acknowledge to the elders of this congregation that you are in covenant with God, being active in a congregation which is covenantally bound to the triune God through Word and sacrament.


