# **Confession of Faith**

**The Athanasian Creed (Paragraphs 6-9)** Minister: Christian, what is the catholic\* faith?

Congregation: Accordingly there is one Father, not three fathers; there is one Son, not three sons; there is one Holy Spirit, not three holy spirits. Nothing in this trinity is before or after, nothing is greater or smaller; in their entirety the three persons are coeternal and coequal with each other. So in everything, as was said earlier, we must worship their trinity in their unity and their unity in their trinity. Anyone then who desires to be saved should think thus about the trinity.

### May I Come To The Lord's Table?

At San Diego Reformed Church, we commit ourselves to observe The Lord's Supper at every Lord's Day service. We are a church that cherishes the Word of God. Accordingly, our service is filled with the Word. We pray the Word, recite the Word, sing the Word, sit under the preaching of the Word, and at the height of it all, sit down to feast upon the Word.

God has already prepared the table for us. So, we warmly invite to the Lord's table all those who are baptized disciples of Jesus Christ, under the authority of Christ and His body, the Church. By eating the bread and drinking the wine with us as a visitor, you are acknowledging that you are a sinner (spiritually poor and sick, as Calvin put it), without hope except in the sovereign mercy of God, and that you are trusting in Jesus Christ alone for salvation. You also acknowledge to the elders of this congregation that you are in covenant with God, being active in a congregation which is covenantally bound to the triune God through Word and sacrament. If you have any doubt about your participation, please speak to the elders before or after the service.
