Confession of Faith

The Athanasian Creed (Paragraphs 6-9)

Minister: Christian, what is the catholic* faith?

Congregation: Accordingly there is one Father, not three fathers; there is one Son, not three sons; there is one Holy Spirit, not three holy spirits. Nothing in this trinity is before or after, nothing is greater or smaller; in their entirety the three persons are coeternal and coequal with each other. So in everything, as was said earlier, we must worship their trinity in their unity and their unity in their trinity. Anyone then who desires to be saved should think thus about the trinity.

This is the catholic* faith: one cannot be saved without believing it firmly and faithfully

Minister: What is forbidden in the fourth commandment?

May I Come To The Lord's Table?

You also acknowledge to the elders of this congregation that you are in covenant with God, being active in a congregation which is covenantally bound to the triune God through Word and sacrament.










- 3. He lives! He lives and sits above, Forever interceding there:



From Psalm 139:1-12






