Missions is comprised of **local**, **global**, and **future** ministry to reach everyone with the gospel message of Jesus Christ.

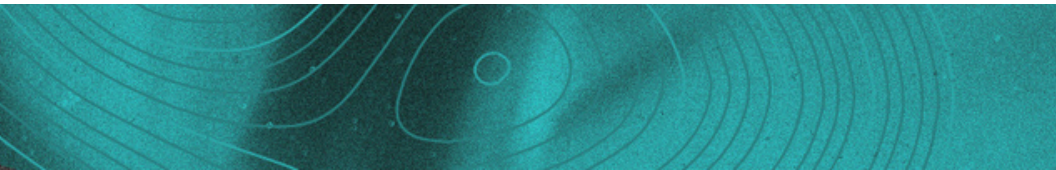
Just as Jesus commanded his disciples in Matthew 28:18-20, we are to continue carrying out the Great Commission.

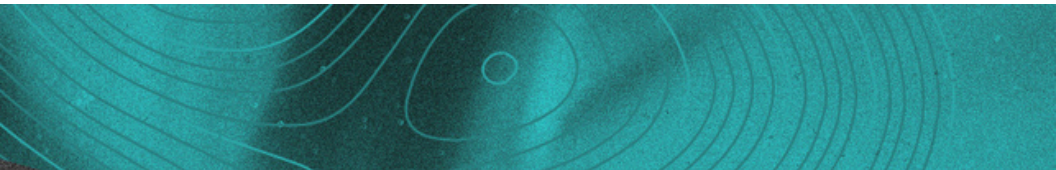

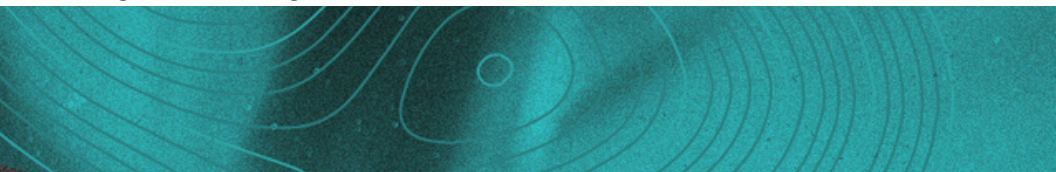

One Day Challenge

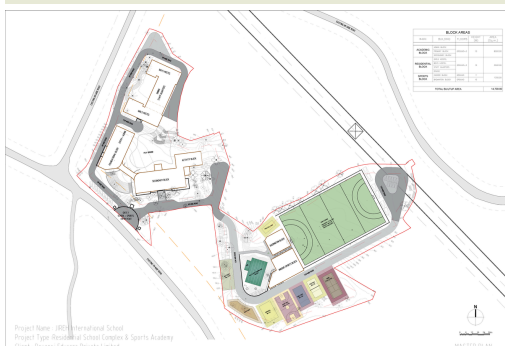
What could happen with one day's wages?

The next step for Project Rescue is to rebuild their school and dormitory that was torn down by the government so that a highway could be built. Jireh International will provide world-class education for survivors of human trafficking and serve as an in-country revenue source with paying families.

- \$5,667 – Provides housing for a child
- \$1,387 – Provides a year of food, healthcare, clothes, education, tutoring, housing, and trauma informed counseling for a child
- \$116 – Provides care for one child for one month

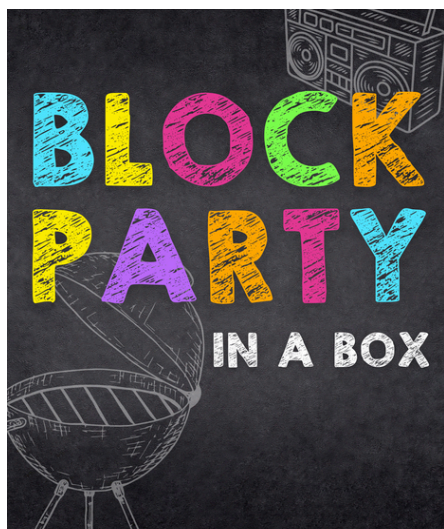
UNWRAP THE TRUE MEANING OF CHRISTMAS

Join us for a week packed with unforgettable experiences! From the moment you arrive, we've got you covered. Your camp fee includes a full day of onboarding and training, where you'll connect with your team and prepare for an amazing adventure. We'll take care of all transportation to and from the Guatemala City airport, and you'll enjoy delicious meals and a comfortable stay in the city before and after camp.

Camps take place at El Faro, a Christian retreat center six hours northeast of Guatemala City, halfway between the seaside towns of Livingston and Puerto Barrios.

You don't speak Spanish ... No problem! Some of our staff are bilingual, and your group will have a translator at all times so that you can communicate with mentors and kids.

Even if you don't play soccer. That's fine too! There's a place for everyone to serve; don't worry.
