Purify Yourself

Key Idea: Revival starts in *you*. Hezekiah didn't wait—he acted in the *first month* of his reign

- What does it mean to “sanctify yourself” in today's world?
- How are we walking — by the flesh or by the Spirit? (Galatians 5:16–25)
- Are there any habits, thoughts, or influences you need to “carry out of the holy place” in your life?
- Are you feeding the right “dog”? (Spirit vs. flesh)
- Is your faith current, or are you living on yesterday's encounter with God?

Purify Your Worship

Key Idea: True worship requires cleansing, sacrifice, and **intentional praise**.

- What “pocket gods” (idols, distractions, sins) do we need to deal with today?
- How can we sow different spiritual seeds in our lives this week?
- Do we more often say “**But I...**” (excuse/resistance) or “**But God...**” (faith/surrender)?
- What would it look like for joy to return to your worship?
- How does obedience play a role in joyful worship?

Respond to Revival

- **Key Idea:** Every revival has **Resisters** and **Responders**. Which are you?
- Do you find yourself judging or surrendering? Critiquing or changing?
- What “party” are you attending—pity party or Jesus party?
- How can we personally and collectively prepare for revival?
