
# OPENING GROUNDING

# PART 1 – THE BIG PICTURE

## Daniel's Vision

---

Daniel 2: A statue of human empires

---

A stone "cut without hands" strikes it

---

The statue becomes dust

---

The stone becomes a mountain filling the earth

# What This Means

The Kingdom of God is:

Divine in origin

Not dependent on human  
systems

Stronger than every  
empire

Eternal

Daniel shows the *end of the statue*

Jesus shows the *beginning of the stone's growth*

Present now

The Kingdom is currently active, breaking in, and visible in small ways.



Fully revealed later

The Kingdom will be completely and gloriously revealed in the future.

# Important Clarification

- ❑ "My Kingdom is not of this world" = Not built by worldly methods
  - ≠ No impact on the world

## Framework

The Lord's Prayer is not just words. It is **Kingdom training for daily life.**

# OUR FATHER

## Identity

We live as sons and  
daughters, not orphans.

Kingdom living  
starts with belonging.



# HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME

---

## Priority

God's honor comes  
before our reputation.

---

Kingdom people live  
with integrity — especially  
when unseen.



# YOUR KINGDOM COME

---

## Expectation

We expect God's rule  
to increase through us.

---

Kingdom people bring  
peace, healing, reconciliation.



# YOUR WILL BE DONE

---

## Obedience

Kingdom living means:

- Quick repentance
- Obedience without  
negotiation



# DAILY BREAD

---

## Dependence

Kingdom citizens trust God daily.

---

- We choose generosity over fear.
- Trust over control.



# FORGIVE AS WE FORGIVE

---

## Culture

The Kingdom spreads  
through mercy cycles.

- We release debts.
- We refuse revenge.



# DELIVER US FROM EVIL

---

## Loyalty

Kingdom citizens stay  
faithful under pressure.

- We set boundaries  
that protect obedience.



## PART 4 — AFTER THE FAST

### What Changed?

If fasting only changed our diet,  
we missed it.

If fasting changed our obedience,  
we received it.

Consecration should produce Kingdom alignment.
