INTRODUCTION

Lewis' apologetic line by saying, "When people say 'Good teacher,' 'Prophet,' 'Really nice guy,' ... this is not how Jesus thought of himself," Bono said. "So, you're left with a challenge in that, which is either Jesus was who he said he was or a complete and utter nut case."
