Read Colossians 3:17-4:1. What can go wrong in this passage if we are not applying it in light of Colossians 3:12-16?

APPLICATION

Paul addresses specific audiences in this passage. How should this govern our exhortation to apply these words to our lives?

What do you make of Paul addressing husbands and fathers more specifically and frequently?

What can you do *specifically,* at home or at work to be a more faithful representation of Jesus?

What is your plan to bring this to action?
