

The purpose of confession is to be able to receive all that God did for you in Christ and enter into it

- Confession is how you receive what Christ did for you **1Jn 4:15**
 - Confession – Homologeo To say the same thing as God
 - Confess with your mouth believe with your heart **Mk 11:23**

Your confession of faith is your part of salvation **Mat 12:34-37; Heb 13:15** (Thanks – Confession)

- What Christ did for you does not become active until you confess it with your mouth and believe it in your heart **Philemon 1:2**
 - Communication - Participation
- The only thing that God requires from you is that you hold fast to the confession of faith without wavering **Heb 3:1-6, Heb 4:14-15; Heb 10:21-23; Heb 10:35-39**
 - Jesus is the High priest of our confession, as we confess Him on earth, He confesses us in heaven **Mat 10:32-33**
 - This confession of Jesus implies all His teachings **Mar 8:38; Luk 9:26**

You're part of his suffering is maintaining the right confession even through pressure to say something else **Php 3:10; 1Ti 6:12-13** (Before Pilate maintained His confession)

- Like the three Hebrew children said our God is able to deliver us but even if he doesn't, we will not bow **Dan 3:16-18**
- We must not bow to the pressure to speak contradiction to what God said

Every person's responsibility is to repent and to believe the gospel, and to maintain the right confession of faith until the end **Rom 14:10-13**

- God is not going to judge you based on what someone else did with his word and the way that they live their life, God is going to judge you based on what you did with his word and the way that you live your life **Php 2:9-11**

If you do not confess it, you will never possess it **Joh 9:22, Joh 12:42**

- It is not your responsibility to get your healing or to get your salvation or get your deliverance. That was God's responsibility that he took upon himself and did and his son Jesus Christ. Your responsibility is to hold fast your confession of faith in Christ until the manifestation of that comes.
- God has made promises of the life that now is and the life that is to come. There are some things that you will possess through confession in this life and there are some things that you will never possess in this life, but you confess them because you know that you will receive them when you get to heaven. Until then we are to live by our confession of faith. **1Ti 4:8; Heb 11:13**
