

- We are not to live by accident or coincidence but on purpose knowing we determine the outcome by the seeds we sow

Your confession of faith is your part of salvation **Mat 12:33-37**

- **MAKE the TREE GOOD and the Fruit WILL BE GOOD**
 - How can you make a tree? Only one way to make a tree by sowing a seed.
 - Our focus needs to be on sowing the Seed and let the seed determine the outcome **Mar 4:26-29**
 - God gave us the Seed which contains all that God is or all He did is in the SEED **2Co 9:10; Gen 3:15; Gen 22:18; Gal 3:16**
 - The SOWER SOWS the WORD. The Word is the Seed **Mar 4:14**
 - The Seed is in the Deed: Hearing, Saying and Doing **Gen 1:11-12; Gen 1:29**
 - She determined her outcome she heard, she said, she did **Mar 5:25-34**
 - When we confess Christ all that He is and did becomes ours **1Jn 4:15; Rom 10:8-10**
 - Confession – Homologeo To say the same thing as God **Joh 8:51**
 - Your confession will determine your direction **Jas 3:2-6**
- The purpose of confession is the ability to live in all that God did in Christ **Joh 15:1-10**
 - What Christ did for you does not become active until you confess it **Philemon 1:6; Heb 13:15 (Thanks – Confession)**
- The only thing that God requires from you is that you hold fast to the confession of faith without wavering **Heb 3:1-6; Heb 4:14-15; Heb 10:21-23; Heb 10:35-39**
 - Jesus is the High priest of our confession, as we confess Him on earth, He confesses us in heaven **Mat 10:32-33**
 - This confession of Jesus implies all His teachings **Mar 8:38; Luk 9:26**

You're part of his suffering is maintaining the right confession even through pressure to say something else **Php 3:10; 1Ti 6:12-13** (Before Pilate maintained His confession)

- Like the three Hebrew children said our God is able to deliver us but even if he doesn't, we will not bow **Dan 3:16-18**
- We must not bow to the pressure to speak contradiction to what God said

Every person's responsibility is to repent and to believe the gospel, and maintain the right confession of faith **Rom 14:10-13; Php 2:9-11**

If you do not confess it, you will never possess it **Joh 9:22, Joh 12:42**

- It is not your responsibility to get your healing or to get your salvation or get your deliverance. Your responsibility is to hold fast your confession of faith in Christ until the manifestation of that comes.
- God has made promises of the life that now is and the life that is to come. There are some things that you will possess through confession in this life and there are some things that you will never possess in this life, we are to live by our confession of faith. **1Ti 4:8; Heb 11:13**
